THE "SCOOTER PATCH ARCHIVE":

The **Scooter Patch Archive** (**SPA**) is a new project aimed at preserving scooter art and culture primarily in the form of rally/club patches and memorabilia. **SPA** is therefore asking for the donation of items (patches and other memorabilia) to be included and preserved in the archive, put on the SPA website, and to be displayed at rallies and other venues.

How does **Scooter Patch Archive** differ from other online patch galleries?

Although **SPA** fully supports other online patch galleries (We're a big fan of them), **SPA** differs because it is not aimed at simply posting scans of rally/club patches. Rather, it's goal is to preserve the patches themselves (and a record of the clubs/rallies) as historical artifacts. Also, **SPA** wants to give others the chance to see the patches in real life, hence displaying the patches at different rallies/venues, etc., across the country.
